



UMPIRES

PLAYER RESPONSIBILITIES

1. All players are required to attend training and matches as directed by the Coach
2. All players are required to attire themselves for matches in the complete official playing uniform of the Club.
3. All players are required to treat their team mates, coach, manager, umpires, club officials and opponents with dignity and respect
4. Players dissatisfied with their grading selection are to follow the official appeal procedures of the Club
5. Players are not to be involved in selection of teams for matches unless requested by the Coach
6. Any misconduct by players (ie. swearing, abusing team mates, umpires, etc) will not be tolerated by the Club at any level
7. The Committee reserves the right to suspend players who breach this code of conduct
8. Players are encouraged to support the Club sponsors wherever possible
9. Players are encouraged to support Club social and fundraising and contribute to club spirit
10. Players are to be aware netball is a team sport and whilst personal development is of prime importance the team development must take precedence
11. Players are encouraged to contribute to Club spirit by recognising and welcoming other members of the Club



SPECTATORS / PARENTS

CODE OF CONDUCT

1. All parents & spectators shall encourage the team's performance
2. All parents & spectators shall applaud good performance and focus on the efforts by the team and their opponents rather than the overall outcome of the game
3. All parents & spectators shall accept the result of each game
4. All parents & spectators shall support an honest effort as it is as an important as victory
5. All parents & spectators shall respect the umpire's decision and appreciate they are an essential part of the game
6. All parents & spectators shall respect the fact the Club has many young volunteer umpires under training and be tolerant of their efforts
7. All parents & spectators shall encourage players to play according to the rules and the official's decisions
8. All parents & spectators shall demonstrate appropriate social conduct by not using foul language, harassing players, coaches, umpires or officials
9. All parents and spectators shall respect the role of the Coach appointed to your team and be careful not to give conflicting advice to players
10. All parents & spectators shall be aware netball is a team game and respect the objective of the Coach is to develop the entire team whilst also improving individual development
11. All parents & spectators who wish to express grievances, concerns or problems regarding players or teams is to be resolved in the first instance by the Coach and if unresolved, by representation to the Club Committee
